



Google Chrome and Scareware

Boy, Bill Gates is being attacked on all sides. But that is to be expected when you are king of the hill. If it isn't Steve Jobs and his crafty Apple TV ads, it's the guys at Google. Yep, that's right. Google is gunning for Microsoft. How are they doing it? Well, their strategy is very clever...

It started with Google Docs (<http://docs.google.com>), the online free versions of Microsoft Word, Excel, and PowerPoint. 2009 High School Seniors

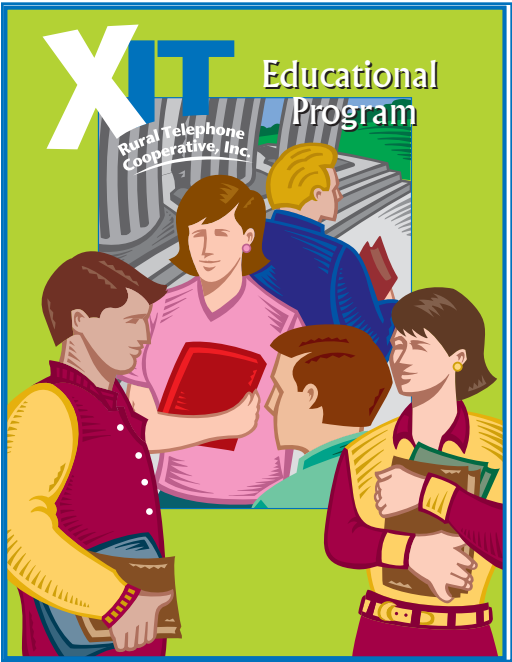

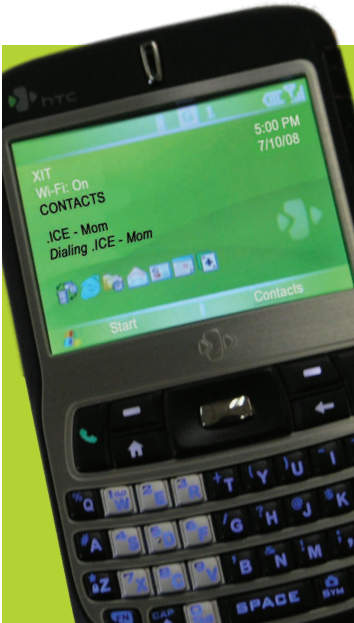
