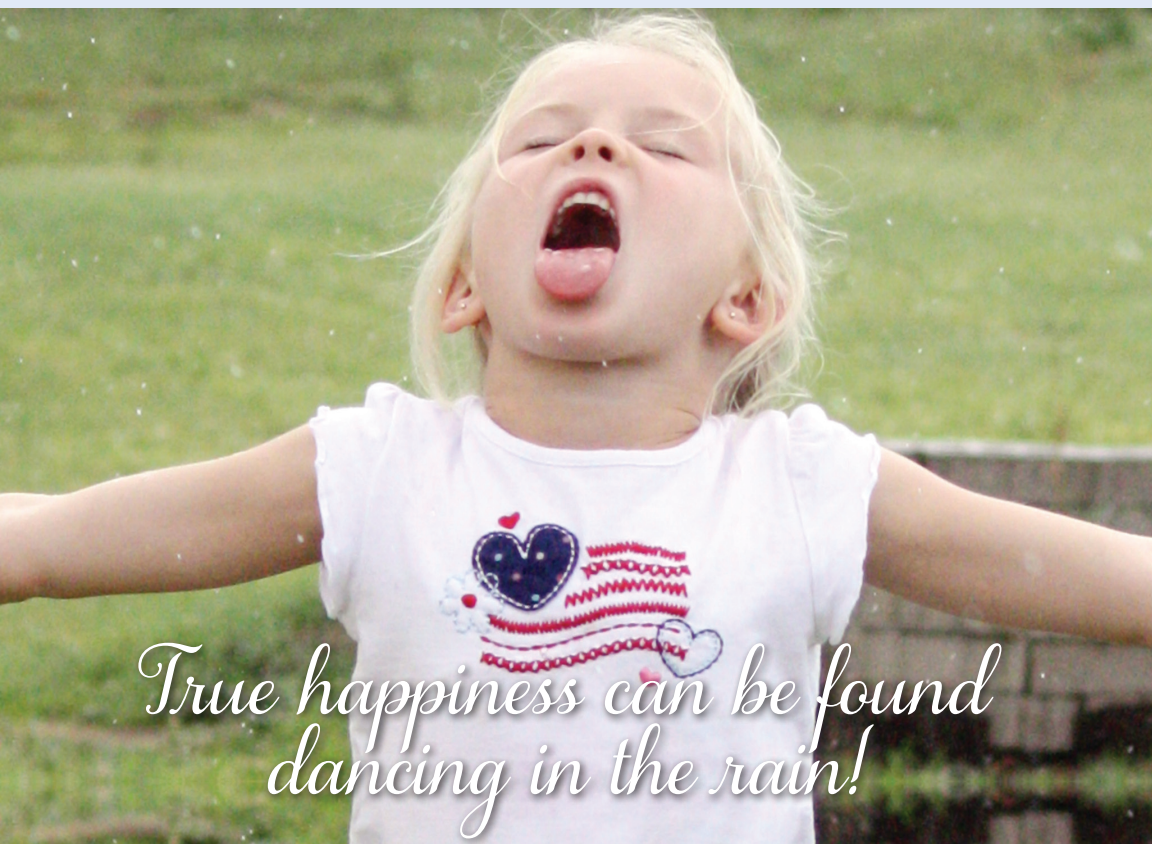

If you happen to encounter one of the local storm alert notifications by the American Broadcasting System while watching a TV show, simply press any button (except volume) on the XIT IPTV remote control. This will remove the alert notification from the screen and allow you to continue with the current TV show you are viewing uninterrupted. You can also press any button on the XIT IPTV remote control when Amber Alert notifications come on the TV to continue viewing your TV show.

## Internet Speeds Within Your Home

As individual families purchase more and more Internet compatible devices (tablets, cell phones, laptops, gaming consoles, etc.) that are used within the home and when all the kids are home for the summer, slowdowns on the Internet can occur. If multiple users are on different devices in the home all at the same time, keep in mind that all of those devices are competing for the same bandwidth within the home itself, all coming from a single pipe to the Internet.

It used to be that most households only had 1-2 computers in the home. Only one or two people could use the computers, so all of the bandwidth coming into the home was only being used by those one or two machines. Now, with so many devices that connect wirelessly with the Internet, some homes have seen a slowdown on the Internet on the actual devices because of this. The bandwidth coming into the home is the same speed, but it is being divided among all the devices, which can cause slowdowns depending on how many devices are being used at one time.

You may want to consider going with a higher speed Internet connection, or limit the number of devices being used at one time, if you need a faster connection for whatever you are doing. If by turning off some of the devices, the Internet connection improves, this will let you know the system is being overloaded within your home.

If you still think your current Internet is not working properly, go to [www.xit.net](http://www.xit.net) and click on the "check your Internet connection speed now" icon on the left side of the page. Begin the test, and it will show you exactly what speeds you are getting from your current provider. 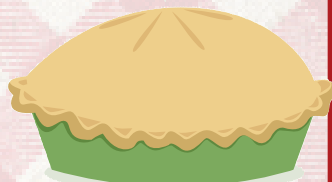

2 ctn. Half & Half	

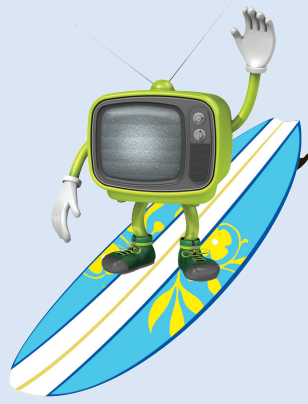

## Computer Shortcuts for Windows

Ever wonder how some people can whiz through computer screens to get things done quickly and efficiently, while others are constantly searching and struggling with how to do things? Keyboard shortcuts can be the answer! Not only do they cut down on computer work time, but make things a whole lot easier to navigate. Once you learn the key shortcuts, it's all downhill from there!

Keyboard shortcuts usually work by pressing down two or three keys at the same time. If this sounds too complicated to do ... keep in mind that you can press and hold the Control (CTRL) key down first and then press the other keys. If you use a Mac machine, use the Command (CMD) key instead of the Control key for these shortcuts:



**CTRL S (Save):** The first rule of computer work is to save what you are doing often. You never know if or when your program or computer may stop working.

**CTRL C (Copy):** If you are doing a lot of copying and pasting, this can save you a bunch of time with your project. Just use your mouse to select what you want to copy, then press CTRL C.

**CTRL V (Paste):** Once you've copied the text you want, click the mouse where you want to paste it at and press CTRL V.

**CTRL Z (Undo):** Allows you to undo a mistake quickly and easily. Pressing CTRL Z several times will usually undo the last several changes you may want to get rid of.

**To Copy a File:** Press and hold down the CTRL key while you drag the file to the desktop or other folder you want to copy it to.

**To Create a Shortcut:** Press and hold down the CTRL Shift keys while you drag the file to the desktop or other folder.

Once you get comfortable with the main shortcuts above, here are a couple more that can make your life a whole lot easier:

**F1 Key:** Windows Help

**CTRL A:** Selects all the items in the current window at one time.

**CTRL B:** Bolds the type

**CTRL U:** Underlines the text

**CTRL I:** Puts text into Italic

**CTRL ESC:** Opens the start menu

**Windows Logo Key L:** Locks the computer (without having to use

**CTRL ALT Delete)**
