- Staples also offers an electronics program for Staples ECash Cards. Go to <u>https://tradein.staples.com.</u>
- Target offers an electronics trade-in program in exchange for Target Gift Cards at http://www.targettradeinprogram.com.
- Amazon's trade-in program is a little more extensive by offering trade-in selections for electronics, books & text books, music, movies, video games, cameras and wearables in exchange for Amazon Gift Cards. Go to www.amazon.com/Trade-In/b?ie=UTF8&node=9187220011.

Remember, with any of these options, the amount of money you get paid will depend on the make/model of the device and its overall condition – the newer and higher tech the device, the more money you will get. And, the amount of money you can make varies quite a bit from company to company, so take some time and check out several websites BEFORE making your final decision.

Favorite Channels

If you are an XIT IPTV cable customer ... did you know that you can set up your television onscreen guide so that you can find your favorite channels quickly and easily, any time you want them? By setting up the favorites list, you can select just the channels you are interested in viewing. It is easy to set up and quick to access! Give it a try!



To set up the favorites list: Go to *Menu>Settings>Preferences>Favorite Channels>* scroll through the available channels and highlight each channel you want to save by pressing the OK button each time. The saved channels will then show over on the right side of the TV screen.

Note: If you accidently select a wrong channel, just arrow over and highlight the channel on the right side and press OK to remove it. Once you have selected all the channels you like and want to view, press Exit to get out of the menu options.

To access the favorites list: Press the Guide button twice on the remote control and Favorite Channels will appear at the top of the page. Now you can scroll through just the channels you want to see – it's just that easy!

Tired of Telemarketing Calls?

Are you getting tired of telemarketing calls? At XIT, we know how frustrating it is when just as you sit down for dinner, the phone rings, and it's a dreaded telemarketer trying to sell you something. We have all been there!

But, there are a couple of things you can do to help reduce the number of calls you get from pesky telemarketers. In the state of Texas, you can register your name, address and telephone numbers with the Texas No-Call List. This prevents telephone solicitations to residential and wireless phone numbers, Texas telephone marketers, any Retail Electric Provider (REP), and all telemarketers calling on their behalf who operate in Texas. There is no charge to register online. However, if you register by phone or mail, there is a \$2.25 registration charge for each phone number you register.

There is also a No-Call List for registering any business phone numbers you wish to have on the No-Call List. If you register online, it is free. Otherwise, there is a registration charge of \$2.55 for each business number you include on the list by phone or mail. Here is the information on how to register for the Texas No-Call list:

- Online at <u>www.texasnocall.com</u> for immediate registration. This option is free-ofcharge and the site can be reached anytime day or night.
- Call the automated toll-free phone line at 1-866-896-6225 to register. There is a fee of \$2.25 for each residential number put on the list, and \$2.55 for each business number you register.
- Send a written request for an application to Texas No Call, P.O. Box 313, E Walpole, MA, 02032. Again there will be a \$2.25 fee for each residential number put on the list, and \$2.55 for each business number you register.

Once you enter your number on the Texas No-Call List, it will remain on the list for 3 years, at which time you will need to re-register your numbers.

You can also put your numbers on the National No-Call List. The federal government has created this registry and once you have put your telephone numbers on the list, telemarketers must remove your numbers from their calling lists. You may register with the National Do Not Call Registry by telephone at 1-888-382-1222. You must call from the telephone number you are registering!

You may also register at <u>www.donotcall.gov</u>. The telemarketing phone calls should stop once your number has been on the Registry for 31 days. Your registration on the Registry will not expire and the Registry is a free service to consumers.

Keep in mind that placing your numbers on the registries will stop most telemarketing calls, but not all. There are some exemptions for companies that you have an existing business relationship, and calls on behalf of political organizations or charities.

NOTE: According to the National Do Not Call Website - Scammers have been making phone calls claiming to represent the National Do Not Call Registry. The calls claim to provide an opportunity to sign up for the Registry. These calls are NOT coming from the Registry or the Federal Trade Commission, and you should not respond to these calls if you are contacted!

Each quarter we will feature tips and ways to make your Roku experience even more convenient and enjoyable. Be sure to check it out! Did you know that you can now display



photos on your TV from your wireless phone with the Roku App? The photos can be viewed from your phone gallery, FaceBook, Instagram, or other applications. It literally turns your TV into a slide show projector! Here are the easy setup instructions:

- First, turn on the Roku Streaming Stick so it is ready to use on your TV.
- Go to the App Store on your phone and find and install the Roku App. It is free to install and downloads quickly. The app allows you to control the Roku Streaming Stick from your wireless phone. It basically takes the place of the Roku remote control. You can also install it on tablets and laptops by going to www.Roku.com and clicking on the ISO app at the bottom of the page.
- Once you have installed the app on your phone, open the Roku App. It will ask you to accept the Roku Mobile App Terms of Use. Check the box and click OK.
- It will then automatically search for your wi-fi connection and if the Roku is turned on, it will bring up the Roku connected to that wi-fi router. It will say Select Device and click on the Roku Streaming Stick showing active to start the app.
- On the phone display, click on 'Play on Roku' in the menu options.
- Then select Photos.
- Click on the album you want to select the pictures from. You will be given album options such as camera, FaceBook, Instagram, downloads, etc.
- You can click on the first photo in the album and when the picture appears, click the Play arrow to start your slide show. You can view the whole album, or if you want just a couple of photos selected, you can click on each photo you want. Then, you will have to click on the back arrow in the upper left corner between each selection to get back to the album. You can also go back to the other album choices and choose photos from them too.
- Once you have all the photos chosen you want to display, click on the Play arrow to start the slide show. Note: If you click on the Settings Icon, you can adjust the speed and transition form for viewing your photos, and even choose if you want to repeat or shuffle the photos.

That is all there is to it! Enjoy the show!

Online Password Guidelines

Online security these days is almost frightening. With online identity theft reaching an all-time high, you can never be too careful when it comes to password use. Whether it be for home banking, credit cards, shopping sites or email accounts, passwords are a part of everyday life for most people. Although no one can be guaranteed you won't be hacked ... there are some



measures you can take to minimize your risk. One way is to make sure you have secure passwords that are not easy to hack or figure out. There are 4 main ways hackers steal your passwords. We've listed them below:

- 1. The most common way is by looking over your shoulder when you type it, or finding the papers where you wrote it down.
- 2. Next is by guessing it. A large number of people use a password based on information that can be easily guessed. A lot of men use obscenities for their passwords, while women tend to use the names of their boyfriends, husbands or children.
- 3. A brute-force attack is next. This is where every possible combination of letters, numbers and symbols are used in an attempt to guess the password. With today's modern computer processors, this method is not as hard as one would think since programs can be generated to do this.
- 4. The last one is a dictionary-style attack. This is when combinations of words that are in the dictionary are used. Software tools can be used to try every word in the dictionary until your password is found.

But, there are ways you can protect yourself when creating your passwords. First thing to remember is never use the same password for more than one account. Computer techs recommend that each password be at least a minimum of 8 characters long. Use a random mixture of characters, upper and lower case, numbers, punctuation, spaces and symbols. Don't use words found in the dictionary, or just add a single digit to a word (puppy I). Another common mistake is just doubling up a word (puppypuppy) or even reversing the word (yppup). Make it unique, but one you can remember.

Once you think you have a good password, check the strength of it. There is a Microsoft website available to do just this. Log on to <u>https://www.microsoft.com/en-gb/</u> <u>security/pc-security/password-checker.aspx</u>. Click on the link 'create stronger passwords.' You can then enter your password. It will tell you the strength based on security criteria. The great thing about this password checker is Microsoft does not retain the information entered. The password you put in is checked and validated on your computer, not sent over the Internet.

Finally, if you have to write down your passwords so that you can remember them, make sure to put the paper in a safe place where it cannot be easily found. Never leave the paper right by your computer. Put it in your wallet or purse, a safe, or somewhere one might not think to look for it.

By utilizing these suggestions and precautions, maybe we can keep the hackers away and not have to deal with an identity theft nightmare in the future!
