## The Dalhart Rotary Club's Court of Courage

For Veterans Week 2024, November 9-16, the Dalhart Rotary Club will set up their 2nd annual Court of Courage-our Flag Salute to Service. This is a patriotic display of American flags located on the Dallam County Courthouse lawn in the heart of Downtown Dalhart. The Dalhart Rotary Club's Court of Courage (COC) fundraiser aims to **SERVE** the community through grants to local non-profit groups, to **HONOR** Veterans, Active Military Members, First Responders, and Healthcare Heroes who demonstrate selfless service through their vocation, and to **EDUCATE** students through teacher mini-grants and students enlisting into the service with life scholarships. This year, half the proceeds made will go into their Life Scholarship fund, and half the proceeds will benefit the local Snack Pak 4 Kids Program. The display is posted for a week, and it is accessible and visible to the thousands who pass by daily, as well as for the Veterans Day parade hosted in our Downtown Area.

### There are two ways to provide funds to this program.

1. A donation of \$50 will get a flag tagged in memory or recognition of a veteran, active military member, first responder, or healthcare worker of your choice.

 Businesses can donate at any of the 4 tier levels. Each tier has different rewards associated.
