

Fraudulent Surveys & Messages

XIT has noticed an increase in fraudulent messages that are occurring on the Internet. XIT Rural Telephone would like to inform our customers of these issues and let you know that these are fraudulent and that XIT Rural Telephone is not associated with these messages or the people putting them on the Internet.

For instance, one of our employees recently was on You Tube and a popup box came up that stated "Dear XIT Rural Telephone Cooperative User, You've been selected to participate in an anonymous survey about your experiences with XIT Rural Telephone Cooperative. In consideration for your time, at the end of the short survey you will be presented with several exclusive reward offers (worth at least \$70)." This message is no way associated with XIT Rural Telephone Cooperative, and we warn customers against participating in these types of surveys as they are fraudulent and may cause harm to your computer.

Another notification that we are aware of came across when one of our employees was working on a home computer. A popup box came up on the screen that said "I see you are an XIT Rural Telephone Cooperative customer. Read before Continuing. Are you concerned that your windows computer may have potential security alerts? Please call toll free for immediate assistance now at 844-772-3078. Please follow these

instructions. Before you close this window, it is strongly advised that you call now for assistance. Support agents are currently available. You can reach one by calling 844-772-3078." Again XIT Rural Telephone is not associated with these types of messages and the phone number in question does not belong to XIT Rural Telephone. This is fraudulent and any participatation in these types of messages are at the customer's own risk.

Please be advised and watch out for these types of security threats. If you happen to come across any messages like this that looks like it is from XIT Rural Telephone, please give us a call at 806-384-3311. We can confirm if, indeed, it did come from XIT or not. We want to protect our customers as best we can and let you know of any potential threats we find.

What's Cookin' at XIT

Lemon-Poppy Seed Zucchini Bread By Sandra Dixon

I c butter (softened) I c sour cream 4 tsp poppy seeds I/4 tsp baking soda2 Tbsp lemon zest3 c flour

2 2/3 c sugar 2 c shredded zucchini 6 eggs

I tsp salt

Preheat the oven to 325 degrees. Beat butter until creamy. Gradually add sugar, beating until light and fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time. Sift together flour, salt and baking soda. Add to butter mixture alternately with sour cream. Beat until blended. Stir in the zucchini, lemon zest, and poppy seeds. Spoon into greased and floured bread pans. Makes 2 loaves: $9-3/4 \times 5-3/4$ or 3 loaves: $8-3/4 \times 4-3/4$. Bake at 325 degrees for 40-45 minutes.

Reverse Telephone Lookup

Have you ever come across a phone number that you don't recognize? Many people will not answer a phone call if they don't recognize the number or know the person who is calling them. XIT offers a way to find the local name or number of that call quickly and easily! It is called a reverse number lookup, and XIT has it available online on our website.

Just go to XIT's website at <u>www.xit.net</u>. Click on the Reverse Lookup Link on the left side of our homepage. Just locate the phone number from the numerical listings to see who the number belongs to. It's just that quick!

Or, do you have a person's name but need to find their phone number? This can be done too! Just click on the Reverse Lookup Link and press the 'Control Key + F key' to bring up a search box. Type in the last name, then the first name. The listing will appear highlighted in blue.
