WatchTVEverywhere

How would you like to take your TV with you the next time you go somewhere? Would you like to be able to watch your favorite TV shows on the road whenever you want? Well, the wait is over! XIT is excited to announce WatchTVEverywhere is now available to all XIT Communications cable TV customers!

So, what is WatchTVEverywhere? WatchTVEverywhere (WTVE) gives

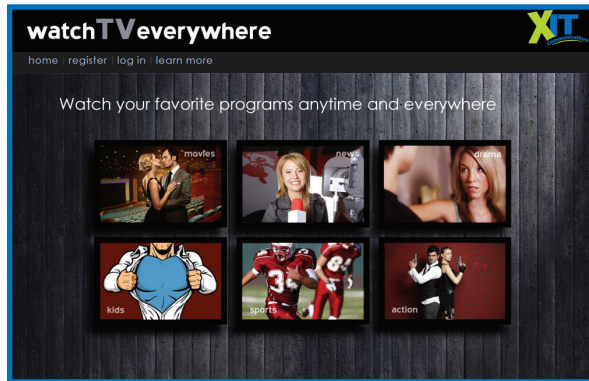
customers the ability to watch TV programs on devices other than a TV set. This could be a PC, laptop, tablet, or even a wireless phone. Best of all, to XIT cable TV customers, this service will be available to you absolutely FREE! There are no extra charges to use it! You will be able to watch any WTVE program that is currently offered, as long as you subscribe to the network/channel on your current XIT cable TV package. For example, you must have the NFL Channel in your XIT TV package lineup in order to watch NFL Network's WatchTVEverywhere programs. Not all networks may have WTVE capabilities, but the list continues to grow!

Where can you use the WTVE service? The answer is just about EVERYWHERE! It works anywhere in the United States where you can receive an Internet signal, like inside your home, at the office, a shopping mall, airport, hotel, and the list goes on. Wired Internet connections and in-home Wi-Fi provide the best quality. However, if you choose to use your wireless phone to watch WTVE, be aware you may incur data charges if you go over your data package. It is best to check with your wireless provider for information on your data package and usage.

What can you watch on WTVE? Each TV network makes the decision about what they show. A TV network may not own the rights to all of the TV programs it transmits. The networks can only allow access to programs to which they own the rights. But, unlike Netflix, WTVE does include live TV, like live game coverage on the NFL Network and Watch ESPN. It also has full episodes of current TV shows within days of their premiere, so you don't miss out on your favorite shows, and you can also catch up on the entire season or previous seasons anytime!

XIT is still in the beginning roll-out stages, so channels are coming up daily onto the website. Not every channel that may be available to our customers is on the website at this time, so check back often to see what channels have been added! The

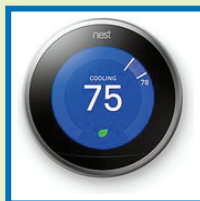


Making Life Connect!

When you have XIT Communications' high-speed broadband Internet service, the world is at your fingertips. Nowadays, there are so many cool and unique Internet-controlled gadgets that can make your life easier and more convenient! Most of these gadgets don't cost anything to operate once they are purchased, but you do need a home Wi-Fi Internet connection to make them work! Then, you control and access them right from your wireless phone, tablet or computer. Here are just a couple of the new, cool gadgets, approximate retail price, and some basic information on how they work. Check them out!

The Nest Learning Thermostat: Amazon.com or www.nest.com are the websites that carry the thermostat, priced at around \$249.00.

- Answer just a few basic questions at the start, then after that, the thermostat will learn the temperatures you like at the times of day/night you like them by recording your temperature adjustments. It then programs itself to your preferences after about a week.
- Nest will automatically turn itself down when no one is home to save energy.
- When Nest spots you across the room, it will light up to show you the time and temperature that is currently set.
- Connect the thermostat to Wi-Fi to control the temperature from your phone, tablet or computer, even when you are away from home.



Independent studies show this thermostat can actually save an average of 10-12% on heating bills and 15% on cooling bills.

Nest Protect: Another great product by Nest is a smoke detector and CO alarm in one. www.bestbuy.com or www.nest.com has them priced at around \$99.00.

- This alarm integrates with the Nest Thermostat and automatically turns off gas furnaces if the carbon monoxide alarm goes off.
- Operates off Wi-Fi to a phone app for easy control and access.
- Lasts up to a decade. No more "chirps" in the middle of the night due to low battery.
- Nest Protect checks the batteries and sensors over 400 times a day, and alerts your phone if the battery is getting low.
- At night, Nest Protect will shine a soft nightlight for you if you walk underneath it.
- It has split-spectrum sensors that use 2 wavelengths of light to detect smoke from both fast-burning and slow smoldering fires.
- A friendly, human voice provides early warnings when something is wrong, instead of the loud, piercing bells like normal detectors.
- Nest Protect will send alerts to your phone, so even when you are at work, you will be notified of any situation that arises at your home.



LIFX Light Bulbs: On Amazon website or www.lifx.com these light bulbs are priced at around \$39.99 for white, or \$59.99 for multi colored bulbs. LIFX colored light bulb give you over 16 million colors at your fingertips for special lighting in the home. LED Bulb is rated to last up to 40,000 hours. (That averages out to about 27 years at 4 hours per day).

- Each bulb is controlled via Wi-Fi and the LIFX app.
- Each bulb has its own Internet connection so you can control each one individually. Remotely control the lights, select the perfect shade and brightness, all from your smart phone.

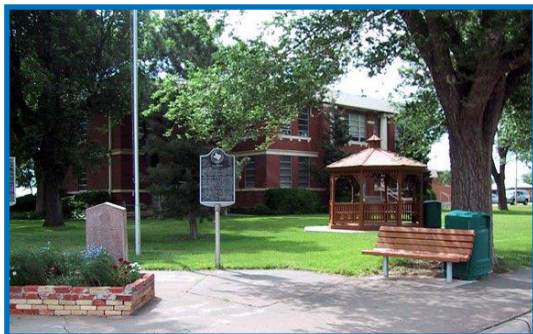
VEGA, TEXAS ...

Vega, Texas may be a small rural town just 30 minutes west of Amarillo, but it's a "progressive" town. CPNI Safeguards!

XIT Communications works hard to provide you with the best possible services and offerings that we possibly can! Our goal is to be the area's recognized telecommunications leader with a reputation for quality, service excellence and value! Under Federal Law, XIT has a duty to protect your service information with us. This includes:

- Disclosing call detail information in a customer-initiated phone call can only be provided by the customer providing the CPNI password on their account; by mailing the information directly to the customer's address on record, or by calling back the customer on the telephone number of record.
- We disclose CPNI information at our retail locations only when the customer presents a valid photo ID and the name matches the name on the account, or the customer provides the CPNI password on the account.
- XIT notifies a customer via mail of any change to the customer's CPNI password, online account, or address of record.

Please remember these steps will be taken when calling or coming into one of our offices for any information pertaining to amounts of usage, call details or services, or any billing related questions.

Strawberry Pretzel Salad by Grace Ringo

| 2 c. coarsely broken pretzels | 1 c. powdered sugar | ½ c. melted butter |
| 6 oz. Strawberry Jello | ½ c. sugar | 2 c. boiling water |
| 8 oz. pkg. cream cheese, room temperature | | 12 oz. Cool Whip |
| 2-10 oz. pkgs. frozen strawberries, sweetened | | |



Spray a 9 x 13 pan with cooking spray and cover bottom with pretzels. Mix the butter and sugar together, and pour over the pretzels. Bake at 400 degrees for 15 minutes, then cool. Mix the cream cheese, powdered sugar and Cool Whip together with a mixer until smooth. Spread over pretzel layer. Dissolve Jello in hot water, then add frozen strawberries, stirring until they melt. Pour over cream cheese. Chill until Jello sets. Top with Cool Whip.

Lifeline Discounts Available

If you cannot afford local telephone service, Lifeline may be able to assist you! If you qualify for Lifeline, the program can save you money by providing a discount on your monthly telephone service. Qualifying customers can save up to \$13.47 per month for basic local telephone service from XIT, depending on their location of residence.

You are eligible for Lifeline if you receive any of the following:

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Medicaid
- Child Health Plan under Chapter 62 Support (CHIP)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program Support
- Federal Public Housing Assistance
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
- National School Lunch Program-Free Lunch Program
- Or total household income is at or below 150% of the federal poverty level

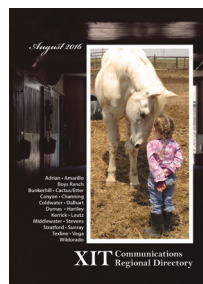
