Call Before You Dig This Summer

Before you start any home improvement projects outside in your yard, please keep in mind that several utility lines are actually located under the ground beneath your feet. These utility lines can include water, sewer, gas, and even communications. Before you begin any construction project (even small jobs like planting trees or shrubs), call 811 to get utility lines located and marked. This is done at no cost to you! It can save you a lot of time and money on costly repair bills if you would happen to accidentally cut into one of these utility lines. Call before you dig!

Texas law requires that anyone digging 16" or deeper on private property or any public right-of-way to call the Texas One Call Center at least 2 days prior to digging. 

Lifeline Available for Those Needing Assistance

Low-income residents that qualify for the Lifeline Program can get federal assistance with paying their telephone or Internet bill. Lifeline is available for both XIT Rural Telephone Cooperative, Inc. and XIT Communications residents and provides a monthly discount on basic telephone or Internet service.

- If you use the Lifeline discount for Internet service, you must subscribe to a 20/2 or higher Internet package to be eligible for the discount.
- There is only one discount allowed per household for either telephone or Internet, but not for both.
- Subscribers will need to recertify once a year.



In order to apply for the Federal Lifeline Program, you or someone in your household must participate in at least one of the following programs: Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Medicaid, Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA), Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit Program, or your annual household income must be at or below 135% of the federal poverty guidelines. Additional assistance may be available for residents of Tribal lands.

A Texas Lifeline discount may be available if a Texas resident's current total household income is at or below 150% of the federal poverty guidelines. A resident is also qualified if they are current receiving: Medicaid, Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program support, SNAP, Federal Public Housing Assistance, Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Health Benefit Coverage under Children Health Plan (CHIP) under Chapter 62 support, National School Lunch Program-Free Lunch Program, or Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF). At this time, the State of Texas does not provide a Lifeline credit for Internet service.

Chili Relleno Casserole By Cindy Tharp

2 lbs. browned hamburger meat
1 chopped onion
2 c. grated Monterrey Jack cheese
3 cans whole green chilies
2 c. grated cheddar cheese

12 oz. Pet Milk (evaporated milk)
1 egg
2 Tbsp. flour
1 pkg. corn tortillas



Brown hamburger with onion. In another bowl, mix Pet Milk, egg and flour together and set aside. In a 9 x 13 pan, layer tortillas, meat, cheeses and chilies twice in the pan. Pour milk mixture over the top. Cover and bake at 350 degrees for 40 minutes.

Some trouble can be resolved right over the phone with a customer care specialist. Others may be more complicated, and a trouble ticket may have to be generated so an XIT technician can be dispatched to your location. XIT has technicians who are on-call for after-hour problems or emergencies that may arise.


